HOTEL OVERVIEW

This luxurious 36-room boutique hotel is located in the heart of England's Lake District, a UNESCO world heritage site, and is set in 14 acres (5.7 hectares) of established gardens and well-maintained private woodland grounds. Linthwaite House, which is on a hilltop overlooking Windermere, is the perfect base from which to explore the scenic surroundings.

CLIMATE

The Lake District has a generally mild maritime climate characterised by ample rainfall. Winters are wet with some snow, and summers are relatively dry by comparison (average temperatures range from 0°C/32°F in January to 19°C/66°F in July). WHAT TO PACK: Layering is the way to go as the weather is unpredictable and can change rapidly in both summer and winter. Comfortable, sturdy shoes, a fleece and a waterproof jacket are recommended if you plan to go walking. Summer: cool, light clothing, along with a sun hat, sunscreen, sunglasses and at least one warm sweater as the weather is changeable. Light jackets or jerseys are recommended for the evenings. Winter: woollens, and a warm coat for outdoors.

LAKE DISTRICT

The Lake District, which is also known as The Lakes, is a mountainous region in the county of Cumbria in the northwest of England. A UNESCO World Heritage Site and a popular holiday destination, with its lakes, forests and fells (hills or mountains) providing a platform for many outdoor activities, the area is famous for its spectacular scenery. The Lake District offers an array of interesting places to visit too, as it is home to many magnificent historic houses and gardens. A literature trail offers a fascinating glimpse into the lives of writers and artists, including poet William Wordsworth and children's book author Beatrix Potter.

THE BAR AND CONSERVATORY

Linthwaite House's perennially popular light-filled Bar & Conservatory, with outstanding views of Windermere, offers handcrafted cocktails and a delectable all day dining menu.

Breakfast is from 07h30 to 10h30 and from 11h00 until 23h00 (kitchen opens at 12h00 and closes at 21h30).

HENROCK

Henrock at Linthwaite House is overseen by Michelin-starred chef Simon Rogan, who has five restaurants in the UK and holds four Michelin stars between them. Henrock, with its stunning views over Linthwaite's immaculately landscaped gardens, showcases natural, perfectly seasonal ingredients in a relaxed and elegant setting. The restaurant is named after Hen Holme (a rocky outcrop protruding from Windermere that is often visible from the terrace of Linthwaite House).

Having opened its doors within Linthwaite House in October 2019, the restaurant was awarded a Michelin Plate just over a year after. Executive Chef Paul Burgalières and Head Chef Cillian Hennessy create a frequently changing à la carte menu inspired by their travels around the world.

Dinners are from 18h00 to 21h30 and Sunday lunch from 12h00 to 15h00.
