





#### **BIRD WATCHING AND HIKING TRAILS**

Linthwaite House in the Lake District National Park offers a wealth of birdwatching opportunities in stunning landscapes. From Lake Windermere's waterfowl to Biskey Howe Viewpoint's panoramic scenes with ravens and falcons, each spot reveals unique avian wonders. Explore the Coffin Trail for diverse species like grebes, or hike Loughrigg Fell for sightings of ravens and buzzards. Grasmere's village charms with various birds and red squirrels, while Helm Crag entices with upland species like ring ouzels. Embark on Red Bank Road for more stunning sights of ravens, buzzards, and peregrine falcons. These spots offer just a glimpse of the birdwatching treasures awaiting at Linthwaite House.

### **LAKELAND VILLAGES**

In the picturesque South Lakes region, medieval Cartmel, located approximately 25 miles from Linthwaite House, exudes history and charm, boasting an ancient priory at its heart and renowned attractions like the racecourse and l'enclume, a Michelin-starred culinary gem. The village hosts vibrant events drawing in crowds, earning it the moniker 'a thimble full of diamonds' from Chris Evans. Accessible via the A590, its strategic location links to Ulverston, Kendal, Dalton, and Barrow, with ample parking available, though limited during bustling events. Meanwhile, in the heart of the Lake District, Hawkshead enchants with its historic allure, quaint architecture, and winding streets revealing tales of its past, approximately 7 miles from Linthwaite House. Culinary delights abound in Hawkshead, offering diverse local treats from pizzas to exquisite relishes. Beyond the village, explore neighbouring attractions like Far Sawry, Hill Top, or ascend local fells for stunning vistas. In Grasmere, situated around 5 miles away, Wordsworth's legacy echoes through charming gift shops, eateries, and the iconic Dove Cottage, while its famed Gingerbread continues to delight gastronomes globally. Finally, nestled at the foot of Langdale valleys, Elterwater captivates with its stunning vistas, village green, and historic Britannia Inn, offering a slice of rustic history alongside serene lakeside walks leading to Chesters by the River, approximately 9 miles from Linthwaite House.

#### **BREWERIES AND DISTILLERIES**

In the heart of the Lake District, breweries and distilleries create a tapestry of craftsmanship and innovation. <a href="#">Hawkshead</a> <a href="#">Hawkshead</a> <a href="#">Brewery</a>, established in 2002 near Hawkshead village and now situated approximately 7 miles from Linthwaite House in Staveley's Mill Yard since 2006, boasts intense hop-flavoured craft beers and a modern Brewhouse. Their inclusive ethos welcomes everyone, including pets, offering delightful food alongside their brews at the popular Beer Hall. Near Bassenthwaite Lake, <a href="#">The Lakes</a> <a href="#">Distillery</a>, located roughly 20 miles from Linthwaite House within a restored Victorian farm, serves as a vibrant hub inviting visitors into an active distillery. Experience immersive tours, exploring the cask warehouse where spirits mature, amidst a family-friendly environment with alpacas and a cosy café. Meanwhile, <a href="#">Grasmere Brewery & Distillery</a>, deeply entrenched in the community and positioned around 5 miles away from Linthwaite House, employs locals and supports communal growth. Their fusion of traditional methods with contemporary flair results in high-quality beverages, reflecting a dedication to both heritage and innovation.

### ADRENALIN ADVENTURES

In the Lake District, a treasure trove of adrenaline-inducing activities awaits. Ghyll scrambling presents the ultimate adventure, scaling rocky mountain streams, swimming in crystal-clear pools, and navigating thrilling routes. Paddleboarding, kayaking, and sailing on Lake Windermere and nearby lakes, approximately I mile from Linthwaite House, offer boundless water sports adventures. Kankku's 4x4 off-road trails, located around 2 miles away, immerse you in breathtaking scenery, emulating the path of 4x4 heroes while promising engineering prowess. Honister Slate Mine, situated roughly I0 miles from Linthwaite House, invites abseiling, cliff camping, mine tours, and canyoning amidst their grounds. Greenbank Farm's Friesian Horse Experience, positioned about 6 miles away, provides life-changing encounters with therapeutic Black Horses. Lastly, clay pigeon shooting at Lake Windermere, approximately I mile from Linthwaite House, offers tailored experiences, safety briefings, personalised tuition, and diverse target packages amidst a picturesque estate setting. Each adventure promises exhilaration and unforgettable moments amidst the Lake District's stunning landscapes.

# **BOATS AND STEAMERS**

Discover the mesmerising beauty of the Lakes through a collection of renowned boats and steamers. Windermere Lake Cruises, departing from Bowness Pier and approximately I mile from Linthwaite House, offers three distinct routes across Lake Windermere, each showcasing varied durations and picturesque vistas—whether a 75-minute voyage to Ambleside, a 90-minute journey towards Lakeside, or a scenic 45-minute tour around Windermere's islands. These cruises feature insightful commentary, allowing stops at local attractions for an ideal family day out. Ullswater 'Steamers' situated roughly 20 miles away, boasts a 150-year legacy cruising Ullswater, providing year-round experiences with flexible timetables and varying cruise durations, unveiling breathtaking Lakeland vistas dominated by Helvellyn. Coniston Launch, in Coniston Water and positioned around 8 miles from Linthwaite House, offers tranquillity and seclusion, hosting two traditional timber launches—M.L. Ruskin and M.L. Ransome—each embracing eco-friendly solar electric power, revealing a Lake District seemingly untouched by time. Keswick Launch, located approximately 18 miles from Linthwaite House on Derwentwater near Keswick, invites year-round cruises exploring the lake's shores with frequent departures, enabling passengers to join or disembark at seven lakeshore jetties, ensuring a serene journey amidst captivating Derwentwater landscapes.

# **FAMILY FRIENDLY EXPERIENCES**

The Lakes District offers an array of family-friendly adventures perfect for kids and adults alike. Begin with a visit to the **Beatrix Potter Attraction**, tracing her steps through the house and grounds, offering ghyll scrambling for thrill-seekers scaling rocky streams and pools, situated roughly 5 miles from Linthwaite House. Brockhole's estate beckons with **Treetop Trek** adventures, Archery, and Pony Rides, located approximately I mile away, while the **Lakes Aquarium**, around 2 miles from Linthwaite House, showcases diverse creatures. Hop aboard the **Lakeside and Haverthwaite Railway** for a scenic journey, positioned roughly 4 miles away, or explore **Fell Foot Park** for lakeside fun, picnics, and kayaking, situated approximately 3 miles from Linthwaite House. Complete the family day out at the **Lakeland Motor Museum**, housing captivating road transport heritage and engaging exhibitions, around 8 miles away, promising entertainment whatever the weather. Each attraction caters to varied interests, ensuring an educational and exhilarating day in the Lake District for the entire family.
